Don't miss it! It's a chance to bid on items that are hard to come by.

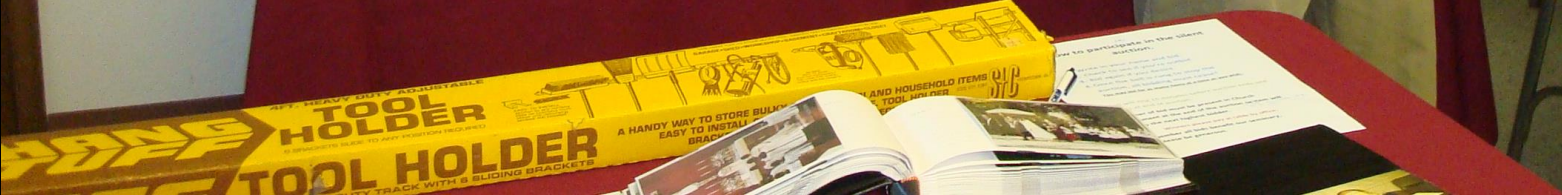
Winner of bid must be present in Church basement at the end of the auction or they will go to the next highest bidder.
