- **Day 1. Friday, May 26: Newark - Lisbon**
- Transatlantic flight to Lisbon

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- **Day 2. Saturday, May 27: Lisbon – Santarem – Fatima**
- Upon arrival into **Lisbon**, transfer to **Santarem** to visit the *Church of the Holy Miracle* where a Eucharistic Miracle took place in 1225 and continues to this day. Pray before the crystal flask that contains the Blood of Christ. Continue to **Fatima** for dinner and overnight. (D)



- **Day 3. Sunday, May 28: Fatima**

- **Fatima**, once a remote village, is now home to one of the most famous Marian shrines in the world. Six times, from May 13 to October 13, 1917, the Mother of God appeared to three shepherd children to ask for consolation and reparation for sins committed against her Immaculate Heart. Follow the *Stations of the Cross* along the Via Sacra, culminating in the Chapel of Calvary which overlooks all of Fatima, and finish in **Valhinos**, *site of the apparition* after the children's return from prison. Visit the hamlet of **Aljustrel** *where the shepherd children lived*. In **Fatima**, visit the *Little Chapel of the Apparitions* and the *Basilica*, where Francisco, Jacinta, and Sister Lucy are buried. Enjoy a free afternoon before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

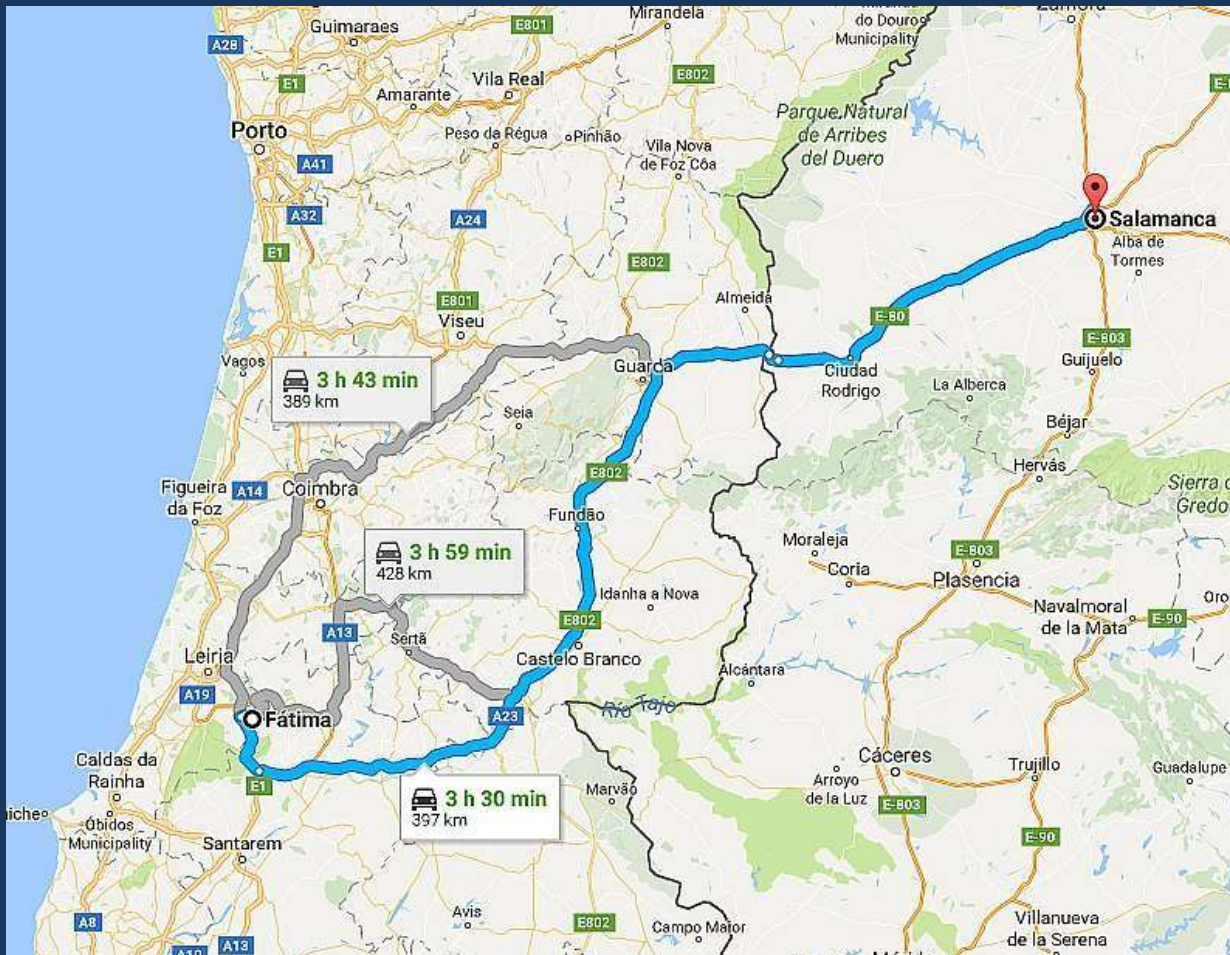

Fatima, Portugal to Salamanca, Spain



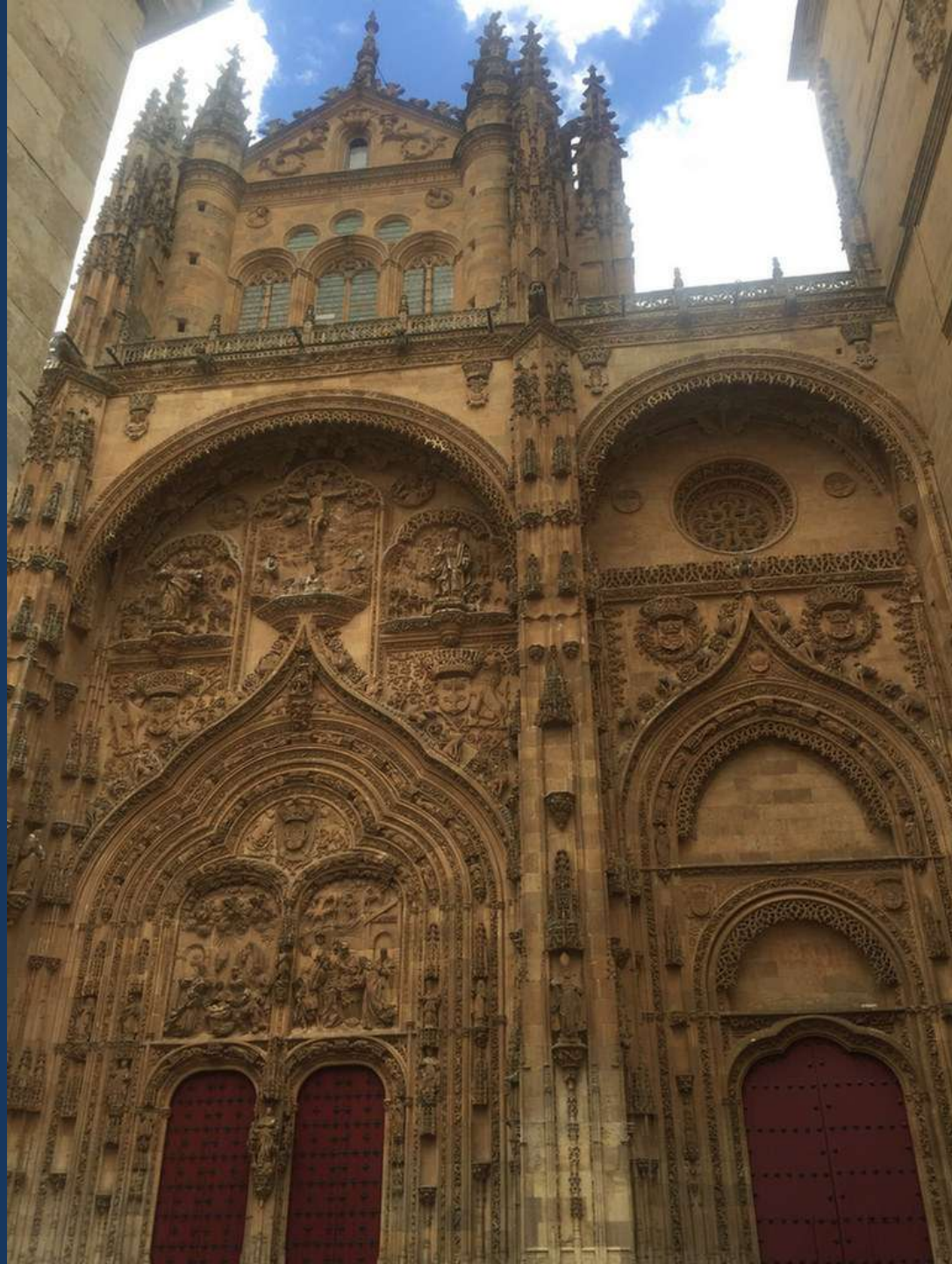

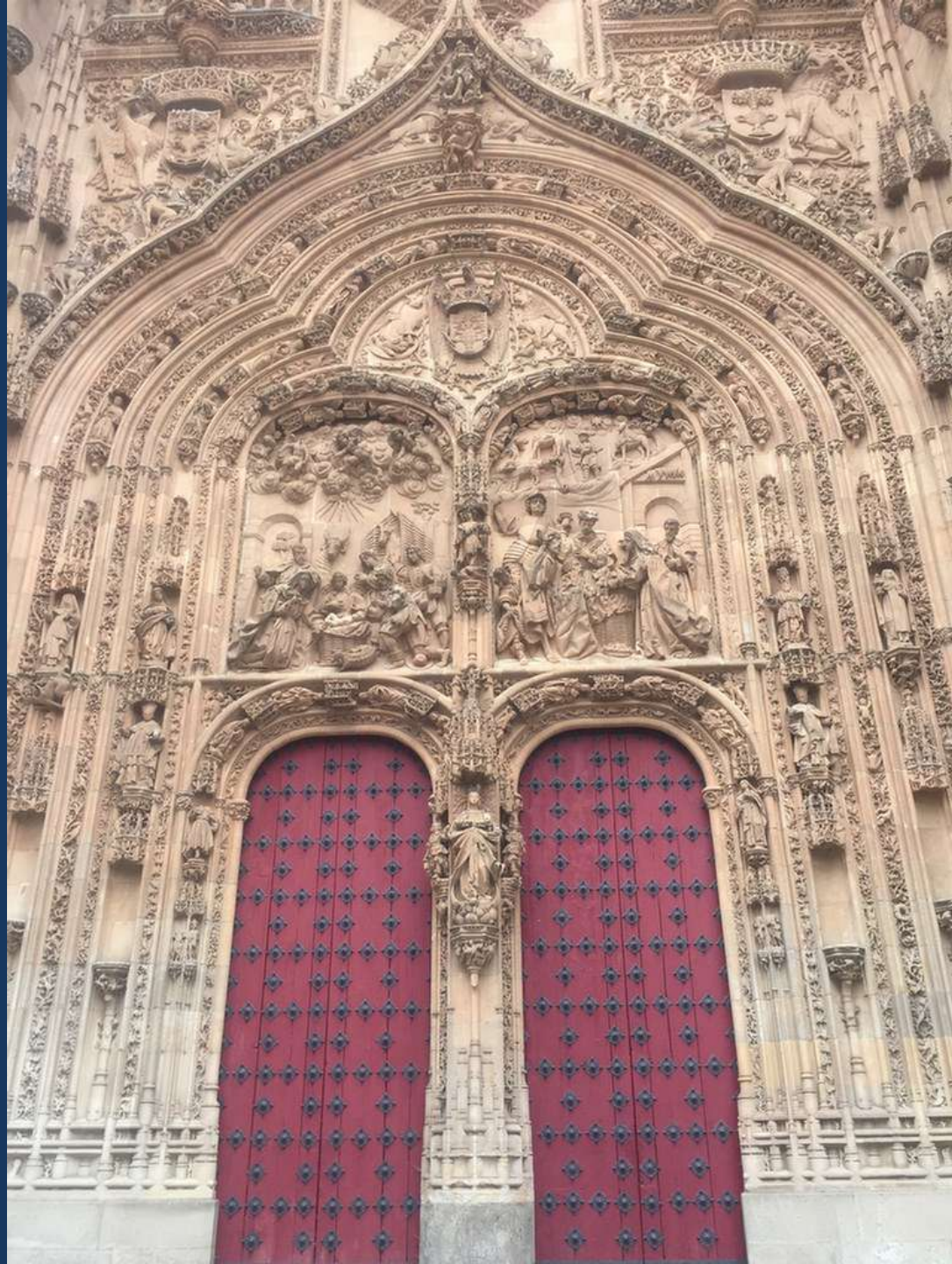

- **Day 4. Monday, May 29: Fatima – Salamanca – Alba de Tormes**
- Travel this morning to **Salamanca**, Spain, for a sightseeing of the center of the city. Visit *the Old and New Cathedral*, one of the most beautiful cathedrals in Spain. Render homage to the miraculous image of Our Lady of La Vega and the remains of Sts. John of Sahagun and Thomas of Villanueva. See the *Plaza Mayor*, one of the largest and grandest in Spain. Travel to **Alba de Tormes** to pray before the remains of St. Teresa of Avila, housed in the Carmelite Church. Return to **Salamanca** for dinner and overnight. (BB, BL, D)

- **Day 5. Tuesday, May 30: Salamanca – Avila –Burgos**

Salamanca, Spain to Avila

- Journey to the medieval, walled city of **Avila**. Visit the *Convent of St. Teresa of Avila*, built over the house where she was born, and the *Monastery of the Incarnation*, where the saint lived for more than 20 years. Afterwards, travel to **Burgos** to admire its majestic *Cathedral*, the third-largest church in Spain, housing the tomb of El Cid and his wife. Dinner and overnight in Burgos. (BB, D)



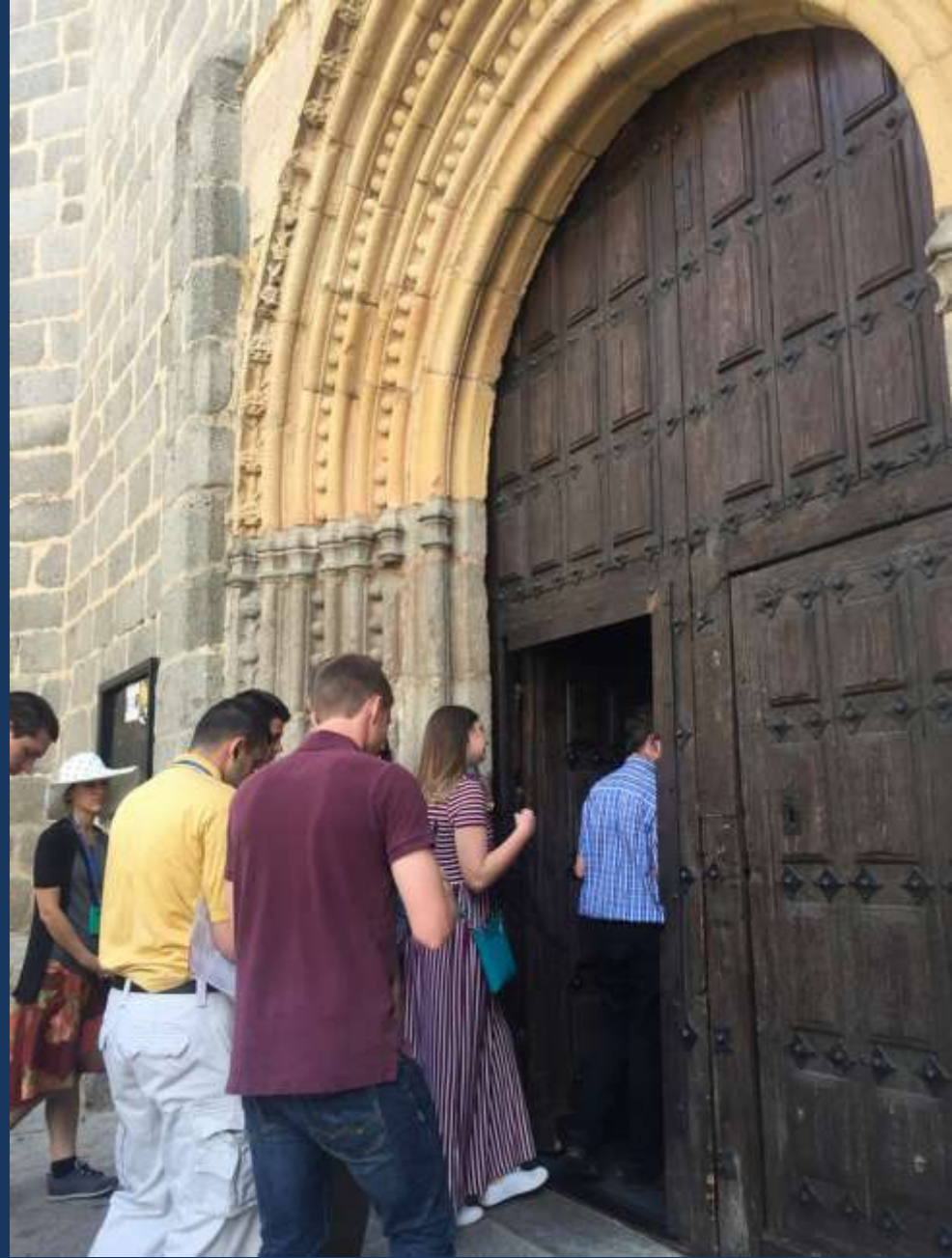

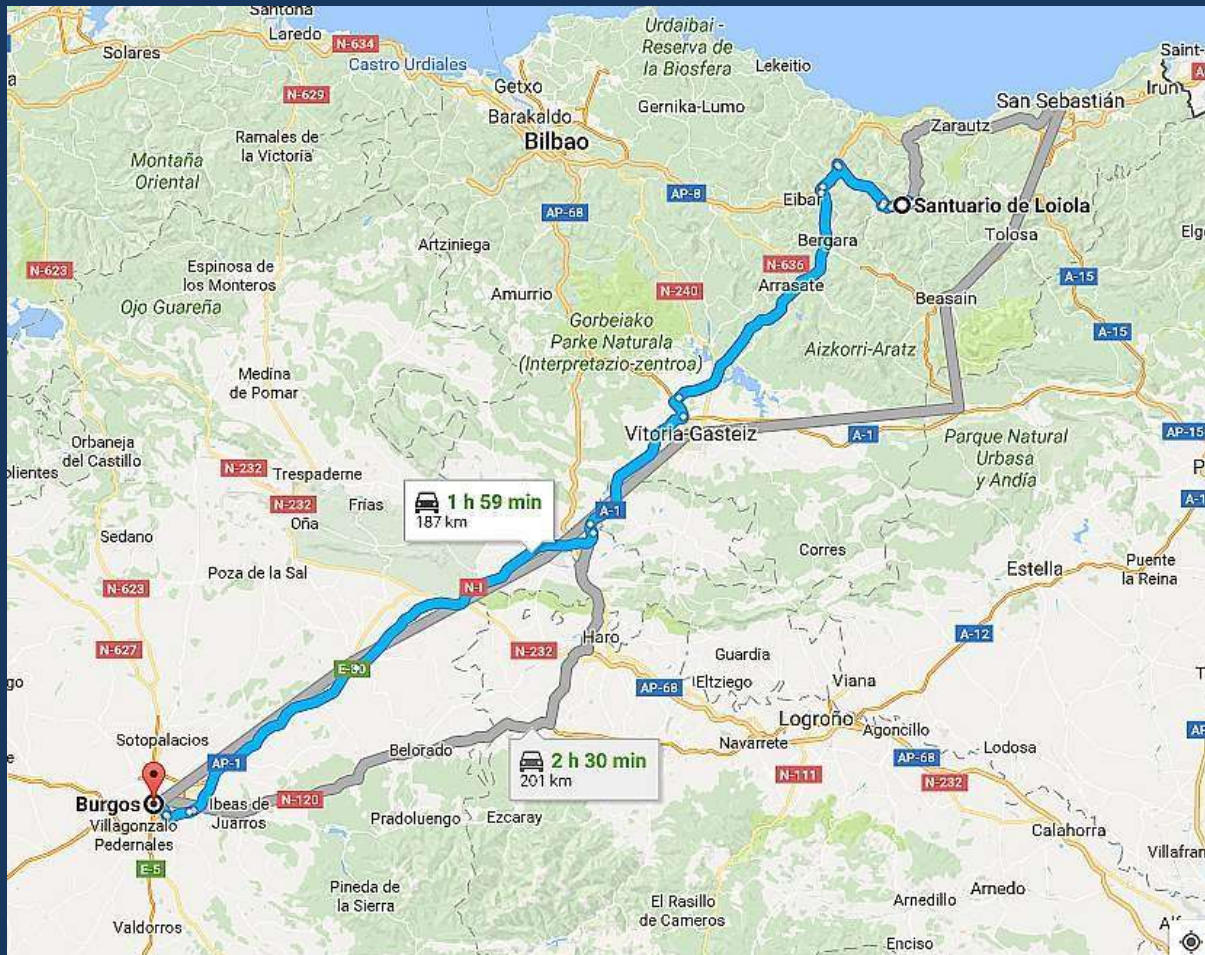




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- **Day 6. Wednesday, May 31: Burgos – Loyola – Lourdes**
- En route to Lourdes, stop in **Loyola**, the birthplace of St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. Here visit the *Basilica* dedicated to the saint. Behind the sanctuary is *his home*. See the room where at age 30, St. Ignatius was brought following his serious wounding at the Battle of Pamplona. Cross the Pyrenees into France and arrive in **Lourdes**, where in 1858, the Blessed Virgin appeared 18 times to St. Bernadette Soubirous. There, you may wish to participate in the procession of the sick and the candlelight rosary. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

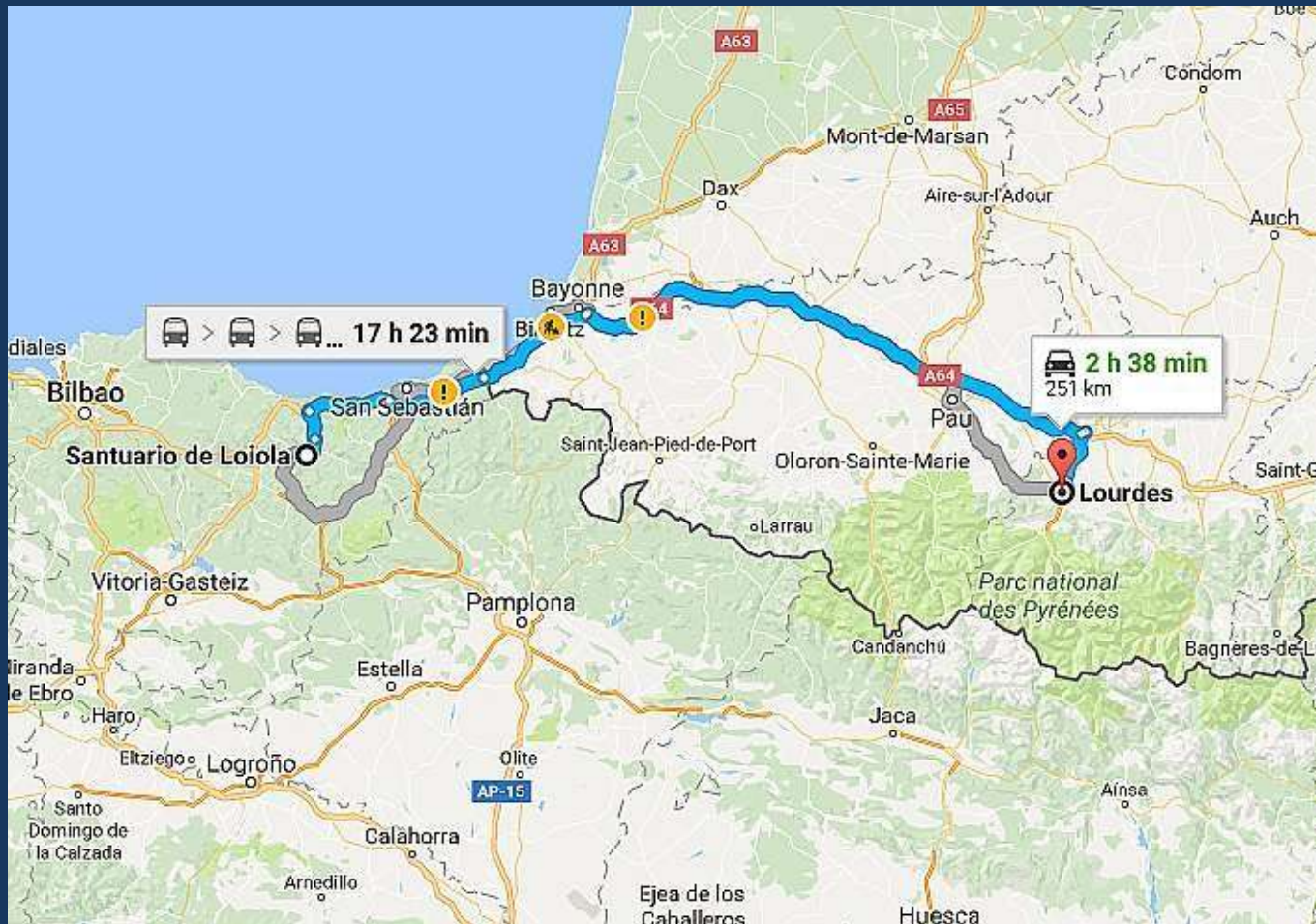








Loyola, Spain to Lourdes, France



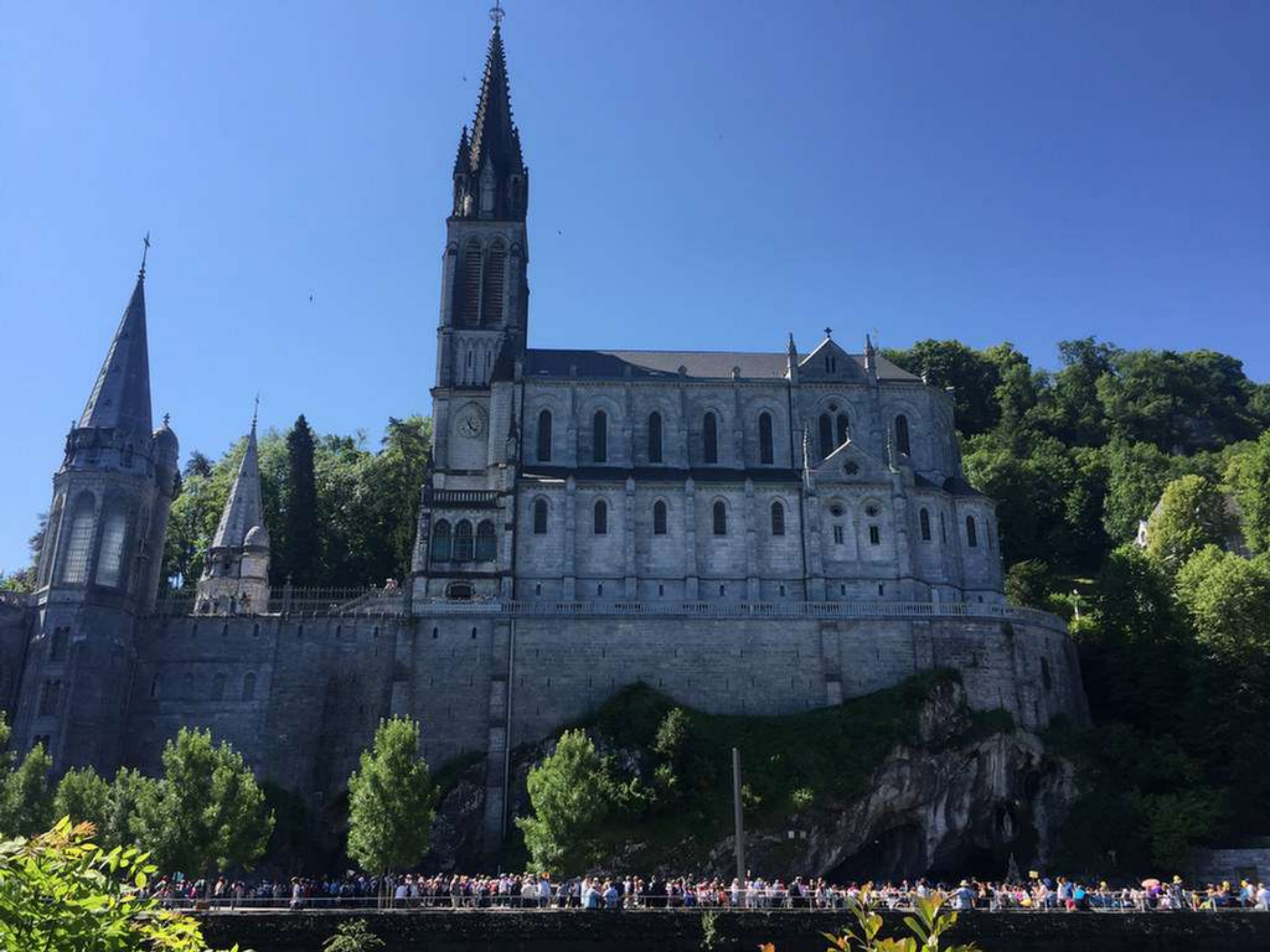

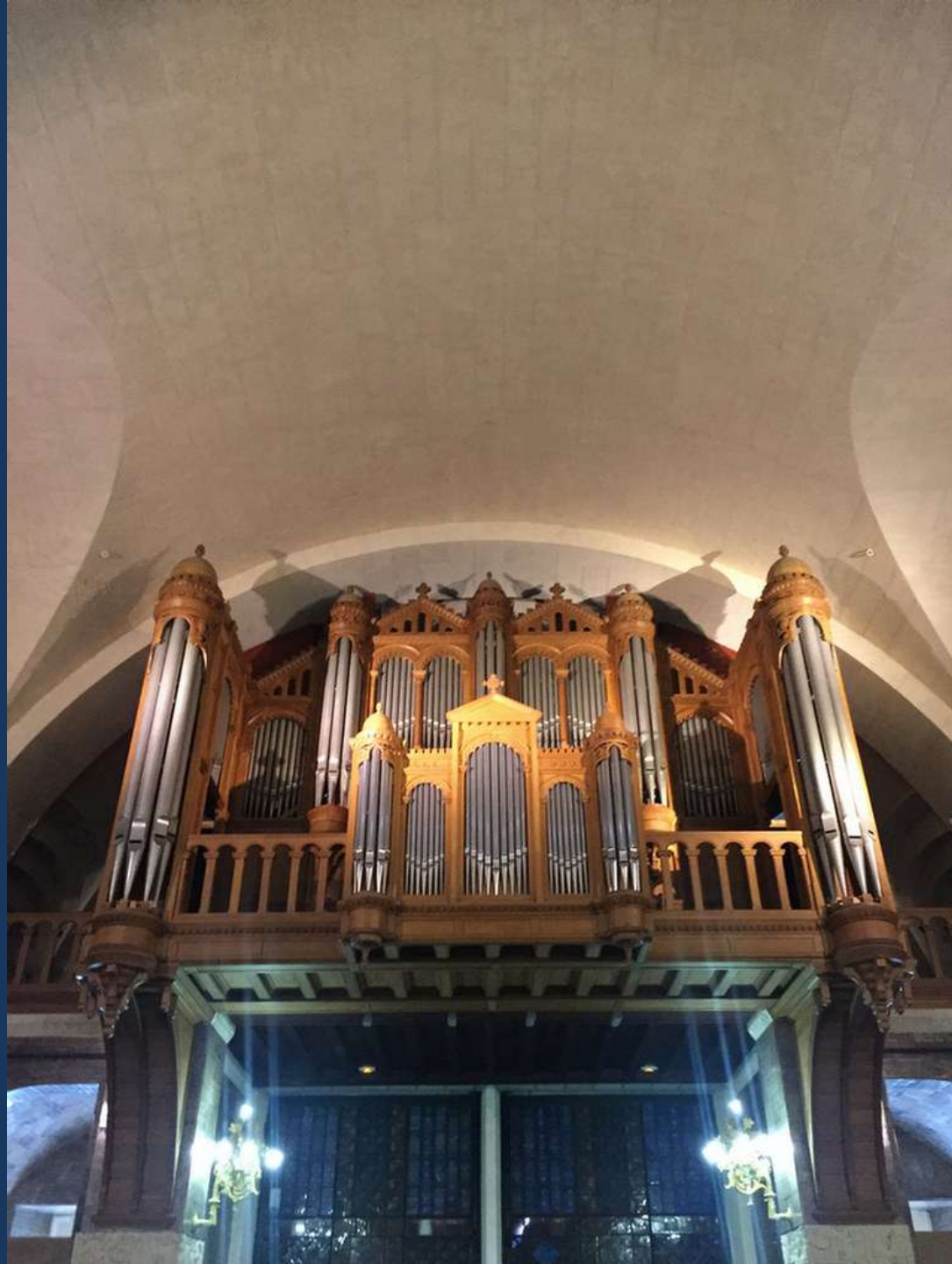












Lourdes to Paris

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- **Day 8. Friday, June 2:
Paris – Chartres**
- Upon arrival into Paris, take a private motor-coach to **Chartres** to visit its magnificent *Cathedral*. Pray before its greatest treasure: the Veil of Our Lady, miraculously preserved during a fire in 1194. Admire the glorious collection of over 150 stained glass windows, illustrating biblical passages and daily life in the 13th century. Afterwards, stroll through the streets nearby the cathedral before going grocery shopping for your walking pilgrimage. Dinner and overnight in Chartres. (D)

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- **Day 9. Saturday, June 3: Pilgrimage Chartres to Paris**

Join thousands of SSPX pilgrims walking from Chartres to Paris. Breakfast is at the hotel. For lunch, bread and water will be provided. For dinner, hot soup, bread, and water. Overnight will be in tents along the way (provided); pilgrims must bring their own sleeping bag, a ground tarp, a soup bowl, and a cup/mug for your coffee/milk. (BB)











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- **Day 10. Sunday,
June 4:
Pilgrimage
Chartres
to Paris**
- Continue on the walking pilgrimage. Breakfast is bread with coffee or milk. Overnight will be in tents along the way. Meals as described on previous day.









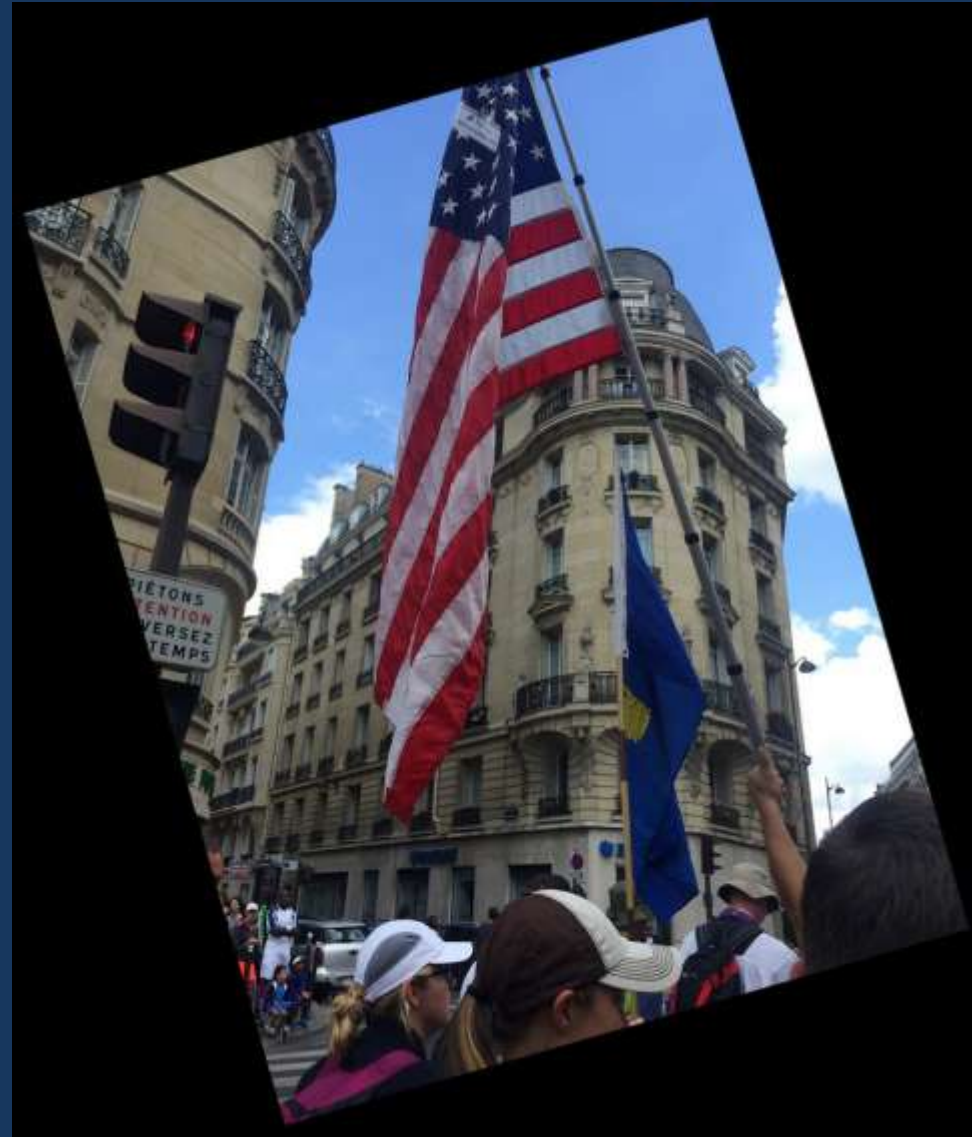




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- **Day 11. Monday, June 5: Pilgrimage Chartres to Paris**

Walk the last leg of the pilgrimage to Paris. Meals as described above. After the final ceremonies, transfer to your Paris hotel for dinner and overnight. (D)















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- **Day 12. Tuesday, June 6: Transatlantic flight to the USA**
- Transfer to Paris' international airport for your homebound flight. (BB)
