







- The Saince-Chapelle was built by Saint Louis in the mid-thirtcenth censury in the heart of the royal palace to house the relics of Passon of Christ, With its unique ensemble of filters high stained glass windows, the Salme-Chapelle constitutes an exceptional example of French High – or Reportant – Godic architecture.




























































